Secondary School

Thinking Skills is an integral part of the secondary curriculum which begins with Key Stage 3: Years 7, 8 and 9. These years build on the knowledge, understanding and skills that students have acquired in primary school. In Year 10, students begin a two-year International General Certificate in Education (IGCSE) which prepares them for preuniversity courses both in Nigeria and abroad. Cambridge IGCSE is the world's most popular international qualification for fourteen-to-sixteen year old.
